4.0 ASSISTANT DIRECTOR GENERAL'S REPORT:

4.1 Assistant Director General's Report:

The Assistant Director General presented his monthly report and answered questions and concerns as follows:

- QualificAction the goal of 15 groups for francization has been reached therefore, the target has been increased to 22 groups;
- the Welding & Fitting Program will proceed as planned. There are six students registered and it is hoped that by the start of the program there will be more. The program may have to be run at a loss in order to build it;
- at this time there are no registrations for the Industrial Drafting Program so the start date has been delayed. There has been interest in this program from international students in the Philippines. This is a provisional card so there can only be one cohort;
- transportation from north of Laval for these programs could be examined. This will be discussed with the Project Development Officer;
- advertising through Service Canada will be looked into and the results of the study reported back to the Executive Committee:
- the direction of Bill 70 is still unclear but if it applies to persons on welfare recruitment for Vocational Training would be possible.

5.0 BUSINESS ARISING:

5.1 Deed & Three-Year Plan:

7.1 Parent Commissioners Report:

Parent Commissioner Sergio Di Marco provided an update on the December 5, 2016 meeting of the Parents Committee noting:

- the committee approved the Enrollment Criteria as presented;
- the committee approved the deeds and three-year plan as presented;
- recruitment of guest speakers to present on various subjects in the New Year.

In response to questions from Parent Commissioner Di Marco, the Director of Schools & Interim Director of School Organization & Transportation noted the following:

- the start times for the Laval high schools for 2017-2018 will be discussed as part of the negotiations with the Société de transport de Laval (STL). The start times, as discussed with both Principals, to be proposed to the STL are 8:00 a.m. for Laval Junior Academy and 8:45 a.m. for Laval Senior Academy. The Commissioners will be advised when the actual start times are approved;
- there is not a lot of flexibility in start times for the high schools in Laval.

Discussion ensued on the recruitment of guest speakers for the Parents Committee meetings in the New Year and the following was mentioned:

- Governing Boards and Commissioners will be invited to the Parents Committee meeting when there is a presentation on the changes Bill 105 will bring to the Education Act;
- the Coordinator of Communications will be making a short presentation in February 2017 on reaching stakeholders and on how to promote registration;
- the Director General will be making a presentation on grants in schools;
- the Sir Wilfrid Laurier Foundation would also like the opportunity to present to the Parents Committee;
- the Aboriginal Education Committee would also like to present.

7.2 Update on Defibrillators in Schools:

In response to a question from the November 23, 2016 meeting of the Executive Committee, the Director of Material Resources responded as follows:

- a survey was conducted and there are 15 defibrillator units in 13 of the school board buildings;
- a quote was requested and the cost of a defibrillator unit is \$2,000 and with the oxygen unit option the cost ranges from \$2,700 to \$3,000;
- to equip all schools will cost approximately \$70,000 with training but no accessories;
- there is no government funding for defibrillator units;
- the defibrillator boxes have alarms on them but a physical person must call 911.

7.3 Lifeline Supports at Hillcrest Academy:

In response to a question from the November 23, 2016 meeting of the Executive Committee, the Director of Material Resources advised that there are lifeline supports on the roof of Hillcrest Academy as well as all roofs repaired during the summer of 2016. The installation of these supports will be mandatory whenever a roof is repaired.
